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ABOUT ANIMELA

AniMela is India's first international Animation, Visual Effects, Gaming, Comics and XR (AVGC-XR) Festival. Launched in early 2023 in partnership with the prestigious **Annecy International Animation Film Festival** and **Government of India**. The festival is an initiative by **Aniverse & Visual Arts Foundation (AVAF)**, a non-profit organisation with a mission to promote Art & Technology in India.

The Festival's primary objective is to empower Indian emerging artists, developers, animators, storytellers, producers and filmmakers by providing a platform with mentorship, education, film screenings, experiential zones, networking and access to world markets. Over the years, AniMela hopes to create the same impact for the Indian AVGC XR Industry that Annecy Festival has done for France.

In its first edition, AniMela's programme has been meticulously curated to reflect its identity of diversity and inclusivity. We are screening 100+ films, 40% of which have been helmed by women directors sourced from 20+ countries. Besides this, 25 knowledge sessions are being conducted by leading names. In tandem, the AniMela-IMC Pitch Workshop is the first Annecy's MIFA Campus in India. It is the first step in providing Indian artists a potential pathway to the world stage.

With many firsts in 2024, we are confident to get better in the years to come.

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



A giant talking frog and an elusive cat help a listless bank employee, his traumatized wife, and a lonely accountant seek meaning in their lives and possibly save Tokyo from catastrophe. Based on stories by acclaimed Japanese author Haruki Murakami, this feature debut by composer Pierre Földes won the Jury Special Mention award at the renowned Annecy Animation Film Festival and the Grand Prize at the Anima Festival in Brussels.



Pierre Földes is a composer, painter, and filmmaker. Born to Hungarian-British parents and raised in Paris, he studied piano and composition at the École Normale de Musique de Paris and the Sorbonne. He has composed for video games, commercials, TV series, and films. *Blind Willow, Sleeping Woman* is his first feature as animator, director and screenwriter.



A mythical cowboy appears in a corrupt 1940's logging town and, with the help of his slide guitar and a giant Hellbug, battles the evil Mayor and his equally evil twin to clean up the town of Sourdough Creek. Hand-drawn completely by Plympton alone in his signature sketchy style, 'Slide' is a vibrant, outrageous, and endlessly entertaining musical/comedy/western; an ode to Plympton's Oregon upbringing and subsequent obsession with all things country western.



Considered the King of Indie Animation, **Bill Plympton** began his career creating cartoons for publications such as New York Times, and National Lampoon. His most notable works include the Oscar nominated shorts *Your Face* and *Guard Dog* and the Cannes winner *Push Comes to Shove. Slide* is his 9th animated feature.

Inés, a Spanish artist living in India, stumbles upon Sultana's Dream; a science fiction story written by Begum Rokeya in 1905. It describes Ladyland, a utopia where women rule the country, while men live in seclusion and are responsible for household chores. Fascinated by the story, Inés embarks on a journey across the country to search for the one place where women can live in peace. Using a variety of hand-made styles, including mehendi, watercolour and shadow theatre cut-outs, Isabel Herguera's critically acclaimed debut feature is also the Opening Film of AniMela 2024.



Isabel Herguera discovered animation thanks to a friend who showed her how to work a Bolex camera and gave her his animation equipment. Since then, her films have won over fifty international awards, including a Goya Award nomination in 2006. She also actively teaches at institutes around the world.

Jagna is a young woman determined to forge her path in a late 19th-century Polish village - a hotbed of gossip and ongoing feuds, held together, rich and poor, by adherence to colourful traditions and deep-rooted patriarchy. Adapted from the Nobel Prize-winning novel of the same name, this magnum opus of the *Loving Vincent* directors uses the same painted animation technique as their previous work, and takes you on a journey of the struggle to break free.



DK Welchman - a graduate of the Academy of Fine Arts in Warsaw, awarded the Minister of Culture scholarship for special achievements in painting and graphics 4 times. Upon graduation, DK became interested in film and animation, and directed 5 short films before her first feature film, the Oscarnominated *Loving Vincent*.

Hugh Welchman - co-wrote and directed *Loving Vincent* with his wife DK Welchman (formerly Dorota Kobiela). The film grossed \$43 million at the international box office and was nominated at the BAFTAs, Golden Globes, and for an Academy Award. Previously Hugh won an Oscar for Best Short Animation for producing BreakThru Film's *Peter and the Wolf*.

Unicorn Wars is a 2022 Spanish-French animated splatter war film written and directed by Alberto Vázquez. The plot is set against the backdrop of a conflict between anthropomorphized teddy bears and unicorns, following two bear siblings deployed in a military mission to a magical forest populated by wild unicorns.



Ablerto Vazquez is an illustrator, graphic novelist, writer and director. The recipient of two Goya awards, he wrote and directed the animated short films Birdboy, Sangre de Unicornio, Decorado and Homeless Home, all selected or awarded at prestigious festivals such as Cannes, and Annecy. He is currently working on a children's series and his self-produced video game, Microbian.

Showing the brilliant emerging talent of India, this selection of 19 films has something for everyone! This is a family-friendly special, which you can watch with the whole khandaan! With many of the filmmakers being present at this screening, this one is all about celebrating the new stars of Indian animation!

Ai.liminate


Himanshu Bheniye | India | 2023 | 3 mins.

Adapted from Gulzar's short story *Raavi Paar*, the film is a depiction of a harrowed family and their travails during the Partition.


Kyaa Hai Yeh Samjhauta?



Collaboration is not just a functional necessity of needing different types of expertise working together on a creative task. Inside Star Wars: Vision-Crafting 'The Bandits of Golak' with 88 Pictures

The Bandits of Golak is a Star Wars story but with a twist; the characters and the settings are all inspired by Indian culture. Part of the new animated anthology series Star Wars: Visions, The Bandits of Golak was created by Indian animation studio 88 Pictures, helmed by Milind Shinde. Who better than him to reveal exclusive visuals, take us behind the scenes and tell the origin story of this Indian masterpiece?

Milind D. Shinde is a stalwart in animation with nearly two decades of diverse experience, playing a pivotal role in establishing *DreamWorks Animation Studios* in India.
